

Tribal Sub Plan (TSP)

Under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP), major attention is being given to tribal people to raise their socio-economic status in tribal-dominated districts through different agencies. In this context, Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) was initiated through KVKs which meant to develop a strategy for tribal welfare through organising different activities related to agriculture, livestock, poultry, goat rearing and other rural-based enterprises

In Zone-VIII, 17 KVKs is involved under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) scheme organizing mandated activities in tribal areas for the benefit of farmers. Special training programmes on quality seed production in various crops; farmers' participatory seed production activities; distribution of quality seed, seed storage structures, crop protection equipment & small farm equipment; demonstrations, exhibitions and exposure visits were instituted by varied cooperating centres benefiting tribal farmers.

Under the scheme, 2.89 lakh participants are involved in extension activities, 941 farmers involved in On Farm Trials (OFTs), 6118 farmers involved in Frontline Demonstrations (FLDs), similarly, 4434 youth trained, 10.17 lakh farmers benefited from mobile agro advisory, conducted 1154 training programmes on various aspects of seed production, storage and quality enhancement, and tested 9715 samples of soil and water for the benefit of tribal farmers. The detailed state wise information are given below:

1. Maharashtra

Special focus on tribal population through Tribal Sub Plan are given by 10 KVKs (Amravati-I, Dhule, Gadchiroli, Nandurbar, Nashik-I, Nashik-II, Palghar, Pune-II, Thane and Raigad). 688 farmers involved in On Farm Trials (OFTs), 1653 farmers involved in Frontline Demonstrations (FLDs), 142212 participants participated in extension activities, 2196 extension personnel trained, Produced 88.92 Quintals of seeds and 2.85 lakh planting materials, 2144 soil and water samples tested, 4.6 lakh farmers got benefitted from mobile agro-advisory during the year 2022-23.

2. Gujarat

Special focus on tribal population through TSP was given by 7 KVKs (Bharuch, Dahod, Dang, Narmada, Navsari, Tapi and Valsad). 253 farmers involved in On Farm Trials (OFTs), 4465 farmers involved in Frontline Demonstrations (FLDs), 147507 participants participated in

extension activities, 706 extension personnel trained, produced 828.76 quintals of good quality seeds and 7.41 lakh planting materials, 7571 soil and water samples tested, 5.51 lakh farmers got benefitted from mobile agro-advisory during the year 2022-23.
